



Guest Chef Night Frequently Asked Questions

How are tickets released?

Tickets for each Guest Chef Night are released through OpenTable. Guests can search for FareStart on OpenTable or use the link that will be shared via our website, social media, etc.

When will tickets be released?

Tickets are released at various times throughout the year.

Are walk-in guests accepted?

We do not allow walk-in guests. Tickets must be purchased in advance via OpenTable.

What is the cancellation policy?

Guest Chef Night tickets are non-refundable and cannot be moved to another event or date. Guests may gift or transfer tickets to other guests if they are unable to attend by contacting reservations@farestart.org or 206.267.7601.

Can tickets/tables be held for confirmation/payment at a later date?

Due to high demand, we cannot hold tickets. Reservations are only confirmed once payment is received.

If an event is full and there are no available tickets, how do I add my name to the wait list?

Please contact us at reservations@farestart.org to let us know the Guest Chef Night date you would like to attend and the number of people in your party. We will contact you if any times become available.

What allergies/dietary restrictions will be accommodated?

Due to the complexity of this event and the many moving parts in the kitchen, we are unable to accommodate menu modifications. However, a vegetarian and a gluten-free entrée will be available, but it must be requested at the time of booking.

Is there a menu for children?

No, there are no special menus for children. Children may enjoy the three-course meal. A vegetarian and gluten-free entrée will be available, but must be requested at time of booking.

Is the restaurant accessible to people with limited mobility?

The FareStart Restaurant is ADA-accessible. There are both main floor and mezzanine seating options; if you have mobility concerns, please let us know at the time of your booking so we may seat you on the main floor and assist you upon arrival.

How do I get to the restaurant, and is parking available?

The FareStart Restaurant is located at 2004 Westlake Ave in downtown Seattle. Directions can be found [here](#). We are located near numerous [transit options](#), including bus lines, the Westlake Light Rail Station and the South Lake Union Streetcar. Free parking is available after 4 p.m. at the nearby Amazon Doppler building with parking entrances on 6th Avenue between Virginia and Lenora as well as on Lenora between 6th & 7th Avenues (across from Amazon Spheres). There are also several paid parking garages nearby, but please check their closing times to avoid having your vehicle locked in and incurring after-hours assistance and fees.
