Donating from a Donor Advised Fund (DAF)

FareStart welcomes donations through Donor Advised Funds!

Please note that the IRS has strict rules and regulations as to what constitutes a grant or donation from a DAF. Gifts that are fully deductible, such as a Fund-A-Need donation at our Gala can likely be fulfilled through your DAF. Paying for goods and services that have a fair market value (like auction purchases or event tickets) is not allowed under the terms of a DAF. Please be sure to contact your DAF administrator to understand the restrictions around your account.

Gifts from your IRA (QCDs)

If you are 70 ½ or older, giving from your IRA is a smart option. Here is some basic information about this type of gift:

- A qualified charitable distribution (QCD) is a tax-free donation from your individual retirement account (IRA) to a qualified charity.
- You must be age 70½ or older to make a qualified charitable distribution.
- A qualified charitable distribution helps you meet your annual withdrawal requirement. By directing the distribution to FareStart, the amount of the gift is not counted in your taxable income.
- You can't deduct a QCD from your taxes, but the savings on your income may still make this kind of donation tax-savvy.
